



GERMAN Seafood – delicious! – Flown in by MAGMA!

MAGMA flow in German seafood, caught either in the cold waters of the European North Sea or in the clear waters of German rivers and lakes:

It is now the best season for **MATJES HERRING**, a slightly fermented raw herring matured by enzymes in pickle. This process was already used in the mediaeval time. Magma gets it from the fisheries of Glückstadt/Schleswig Holstein, which are famous since centuries for their delicious prepared Matjes.

Another seafood delicacy we fly in are **BUESUM KRABBEN** (North Sea shrimps). Since hundred of years the small village „Buesum“ is famous for the best shrimps. They will be caught at deep sea and shelled and prepared in Buesum. The are smaller, but much more delicious than the farmed shrimps!

We offer you some other delicious German seafood dishes:

- **ROLLMOPS** – a small pickled herring fillet, rolled around a slice of pickled gherkin
- **BRATHERING** – fried whole herring, pickled in a marinade of vinegar and herbs
- **Beechwood smoked freshwater EEL** – medium sized eels (whole eel is about 300 g net)
